Stay & Play morning 9-10.30

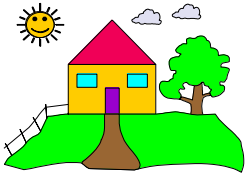
This is the first of our stay and play mornings where parents get the opportunity to see what their little ones are getting up to in nursery. All are welcome to attend.
